English: In our writing this term, we will be using the text 'Inside the Villains' to create a fairytale for an intended audience, looking at setting and character as well as key vocabulary choices. We will use 'My Secret War Diary' to link with our theme of WW2 and will be looking at a range of verb forms. Our non-fiction writing will link to our WW2 theme and include letters and informative texts and we will learn about layout devices and using cohesion through paragraphs.

Science: Life Cycles is where we start the Summer Term. We will look at the life cycles of different animals and plants and look at how humans develop throughout their life. After the half term, we will continue to build on the learning from the last few terms and look at classification.

DT/Art: Stags will be working on landscapes with Mrs Buckley and use inspiration from the likes of Turner. DT will be researching, designing, making and evaluating photo frames using a range of skills.

Religious Education: The Summer Term begins with the topic of 'Jesus the Saviour'. We will look at his life and the miracles he performed. We will then move on to thinking about the question, 'Does Faith Help?'.

Home Learning: SATS revision will continue to be sent home for Year 6. Children should be practising their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. A WWII Homework Menu will be sent out this week.

Maths: Pupils in Year 5 and 6 will start by focussing on shape - this covers a range of mathematics including angles, perimeter and area. Year 5 will also explore negative numbers, units of measurement and decimals. Year 6 will revise and after SATS, continue to solidify understanding that will be useful for Year 7. Arithmetic tests will take place on a weekly basis.

PSHE: Borrowing and Earning Money.

Pupils will learn that money can be borrow but there are risks, about enterprise and what influences people's career choices.

Making Changes.

Year 6 will look at how the body changes during puberty and children will learn about being protected against FGM.

Computing: Over the first 6 weeks, we will complete our Variables in Games learning that uses scratch to program.

During the second half of term, children will delve into Digital Creativity and 3D Modelling.

History and Geography: In History this term we will start by delving into how WWII began and how it affected the world on a global scale. We will look at the axis and allies, key individuals and the Home Front - We will consider the part that everyone played in order to be victorious.

Class Book: This term we will read 'When The Sky Falls' by Phil Earle and then 'Can You See Me?' by Libby Scott and Rebecca Wescott. Feel free to buy these books so your child can bring it in and read along.

PE:

Pupils will have an extended PE lesson on a Monday and over the Summer Term will be looking at the rules and skills needed for Rounders as well as focussing on Athletics, too.

Music: Mrs Buckley will be teaching the children to compose their own hip hop tracks online. They will look at how a range of instruments can be combined and perform them to each other.

French: The last two terms will include 'Ordering at the café' and 'Professions'. Both will involve speaking, listening and writing.
