

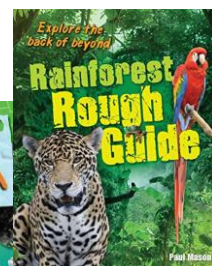
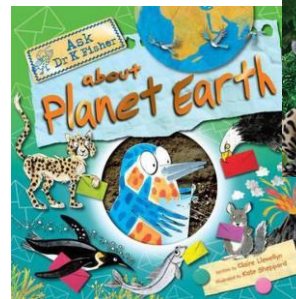
Buzzards Class

English: This term, we will be exploring a range of texts including letters, guides and setting descriptions. **Ask Dr K Fisher About Planet Earth** follows Dr Fisher as she travels around the world looking at different animals and areas. **There's a Rang Tan in my Bedroom** will allow us to explore different settings through different animals. Our final text is **Rainforest Rough Guide**. This book explores the rainforest and we will write a guide all about the rainforest for someone to follow.



Maths: Pupils will focus on **Length and Perimeter** when they first return. We will measure length in millimetres, centimetres, metres and kilometres. We will also measure and calculate perimeter. We will then move onto **Fractions**. We will understand the different parts of a fraction, explore equivalent fractions and convert fractions. **Mass and Capacity** is our next unit. We will measure in grams, kilograms, millilitres and litres. We will return to **Fractions** for our final unit. We will be adding and subtracting unit and non-unit fractions in this unit. We will also continue completing weekly arithmetic assessments.

Science: This term we will be looking at **Plants**. This topic will focus on the different parts of a plant, the function of these plants and plant reproduction. We will then move onto **Electricity** and we will identify electrical appliances, create circuits and explore whether materials are a conductor or insulator.

Geography/History: This term we will be looking at **The United Kingdom**. This unit looks at the countries and counties within the UK. We will identify human and physical features. We will also be improving our map skills and using 4-figured grid references to help us read a map. We will end the unit creating a detailed map of our local area.

DT/Art: In Art, we will continue exploring the **Monochromatic** style of work. Pupils will have the opportunity to create their own piece of art in this style. **Sculpture** is our next topic and we will be inspired by Mexican artists.

PSHE:
Tobacco is a Drug. In this unit we will look at the definitions of a drug and that they can be harmful. We will also look at the effects and risks of second-hand smoke.

PE:
Pupils will have a weekly PE session with Mr Dovell. This will be on a Tuesday, please send your child in wearing their PE kit. During these sessions they will build upon a range of skills and learn the rules of different sports.

Computing: This term we will be exploring the units, **Stop Frame Animation and Audio Production**. We will also explore the units **Protect Your Stuff and Respect Each Other** in our e-safety lessons.

Making Choices. This unit focuses on making good choices around drugs, medicines and alcohol.

French: We will look at three units this term. These are:
My Family, Dates and Birthdays and Pets.

Music: Mrs Devereaux will be teaching the pupils a range of instruments and the skills they need to perform. Lessons will happen every week and each child will have the opportunity to play and perform with an instrument.

Religious Education: This term we will be exploring **What is it like for someone to follow God?**

We will then move on to the questions, **How do Festivals and Worship show what matters to a Muslim?**
