




# Butterflies Class

## Autumn Term 2025-2026

**English:** In our writing this term, we will be using "This is How We Do it" as our inspiration. The children will write their own information text about themselves, their families and their lives. We will be working hard to develop our fundamental writing skills of handwriting, using capital letters and full stops and using phonic knowledge to spell words.

**Maths:** Our first unit this term will be place value, where we will learn about how ones and tens can be used to help us build numbers. We will then move on to adding and subtracting numbers up to 20. Finally, we will consolidate our knowledge and understanding of 2D shapes and begin to think about 3D ones too.

**Science:** This term we will be looking at **Everyday Materials**. We will learn about the properties of different materials that we use in every day life and think about how those properties help them to be suited to certain uses. We will also start to think about **Seasonal Changes**.

**History:** In History this term, we will be learning about "**Famous Explorers**". What sort of adventures will our famous explorers go on and what amazing things will they discover?

**Geography:** In Geography, we will be investigating "**Weather and Climate**". We will be finding out the difference between weather and climate and comparing ours to other countries around the world.

**DT/Art:** In **Art** we will be using colour to create abstract artwork. We will be using the work of Hilma af Klint as inspiration. In **DT**, children will be designing and making their own bookmarks using textiles.

**Home Learning:** Y1 pupils should read regularly using the Collins Big Cat online platform. We will also send home our "sound of the week" to practice at home. Y2 pupils should access our online spelling shed weekly and read at home at least 3 times a week. We will also provide some maths consolidation questions for both year groups at the end of each maths unit.

**PSHE:**  
**What we put into our bodies**  
Pupils learn:  
-about what can go into bodies and how it can make people feel  
-how this can make us healthy or unhealthy

**Music:** Mrs Devereaux will be teaching children how to use their hands, feet and heart to enjoy South African Afropop. They will need to listen with concentration to a range of different songs. In preparation for our Harvest Service, pupils will also be using their voices expressively to practice their performance.

**Religious Education:** This term we will be learning **Who is Muslim and how do they live?**

**PE:**  
Pupils will have PE every Wednesday with Mrs Eggleton. We will be learning fundamental skills, such as balance and coordination.

**Computing:**  
**E-Safety** – Pupils will learn how to "Think before you share".  
**Teach computing** – Pupils will be collecting, grouping labelling and matching data and information, comparing it other data and asking questions about what it might mean.
