English: In our writing this term, we will be focusing on narrative, based around the book Charlotte's Web. We will focus in depth on character and setting descriptions, as well as looking at the rules of speech. We will then finish by creating our own narrative piece inspired by Charlotte's Web.

Maths: In maths, we will be starting with a focus on place value, by exploring numbers up to 10 million, and also by exploring negative numbers. Later in the half term, we will move into looking at our 4 operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Science: To start the year in science, we will focus on biology, and more specifically evolution. We will look at adaptations made by both plants and animals to best suit their environments, before moving onto looking at natural selection. We will then focus on which characteristics we have inherited from our parents.

History and Geography: This term in History, we will look at WW2. We will focus on Britain and Germany pre-war, and how the war came about. We will then focus on the role of the RAF within the defence of the UK, as well as which major battles helped forge our victory!

DT/Art: In Art sessions, we will focus on monochromatic and drawing, focusing on portraits. We will also look at textiles in DT.

PSHE: We will learn focus on mental health and wellbeing. These sessions will emotions and feelings, loss and grief and how these may make our body feel.

PE: We will have one P.E afternoon per week, on a Tuesday, and we will be focusing on gymnastics.

Music: Mrs. Devereaux will be teaching the children music, and will focus on pop and neo soul.

Home Learning: All pupils should read a minimum of three times a week, with an adult listening for at least one session. Pupils should also access TT Rockstars and the spelling shed weekly. There may also be some weekly homework based on the topics we have learned in class.

Computing: In this session, we will be focusing on databases, including how to make databases, and how to search them effectively.

Religious Education: This term we will be focussing on **Hinduism**, and why Hindu's want to be good.

French: This term, we will be focusing on a review of the French numbers from 1-100.
