English: In our writing this term, we will be focusing on persuasive writing and instruction writing. We will be creating machines inspired by Wallace and Gromit's Cracking Contraptions, and writing advertisement pieces to sell them, as well as instructional pieces about how they work.

Maths: In maths, we are moving onto multiplication and division, and formal methods. We will be looking at both column multiplication, and column division, and how to apply these into real life situations. We will then look at a second block of fractions, before moving into decimals.

Science: In science, we will be exploring the topic of light. We will look at how shadows are formed, and how they change and react to the position of a light source. We will then look at the role of mirrors, water, and the eye in how we see and perceive different objects.

History and Geography: This term in geography, we will be taking part in an in-depth study of the UK. We will look closely at the four countries that make up the UK, and the settlements and features of each. We will then look into sustainability, and how the UK is sustainable in a number of different areas.

DT/Art: In Art sessions, we will focus how art can send a message. We will look at art that has been used in protests, as well as to help promote certain causes.

PSHE: We will learn focus on drug and alcohol education. We will focus on the dangers of smoking and alcohol, and begin awareness of peer pressure.

PE: We will have one P.E afternoon per week, on a Tuesday, and we will be focusing on dance.

Music: Mrs. Devereaux will be teaching the children music, and will focus on the recorder.

Home Learning: All pupils should read a minimum of three times a week, with an adult listening for at least one session. Pupils should also access TT Rockstars and the spelling shed weekly. There may also be some weekly homework based on the topics we have learned in class.

Computing: In this session, we will be focusing on creating media, and how we can effectively create 3d models and diagrams.
