English: Focused texts will include *Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World*. This book looks at biographies from amazing scientists, sports women and historians. We will then write our own biographies. *I Don't Believe it Archie!* is our next text. We will explore the book and write our own chapter. We will then end the term writing an information text based on **Dare to Care: Pet Dragon**.



Science: This term we will be looking at **States of Matter**. We will explore solids, liquids and gases and understand how these states change and differ. We will explore evaporation, different liquids, thermometer use and the water cycle.

Geography/History: In geography, we will be exploring the unit **My Region and Campania, Italy**. This is a really lovely unit that allows us to explore our local region of the **South West** and compare it to Campania, Italy. We will look at the physical and human features of both locations and explore how this contributes to different natural disasters and land uses.

DT/Art: In **Art**, we will be exploring the Chromatic style of work. Pupils will have the opportunity to create their own piece of art in this style. In **DT** we will be exploring Textiles and creating our own item. We will be building on last terms work.

Religious Education: This term we will be focussing on **Hinduism**. We will be exploring what it is like to be a Hindu in Britain today. Our next focus will be **Christianity**, exploring what happened on the lead up and day of 'Good Friday'.

French: We will look at two units this term. These will be: **At the Farm and At the Home**. We will continue to improve our French speaking and writing skills.

Music: Mrs Devereaux will be teaching the pupils a range of instruments and the skills they need to perform. Lessons will happen every week and each child will have the opportunity to play and perform with an instrument.

Computing:

This term we will be exploring the unit, **Creating Media**. We will look at different ways to create digital media, evaluate our digital media and recognise why it is important.

Maths: Pupils will begin the term focussing on **Area**. Then we will continue with the great work we have been doing in **Multiplication and Division B**. This unit applies the skills we learnt last term. We will continue to work on and improve our **times tables recall**. We then move onto **Length and Perimeter**, exploring these concepts in different ways. **Fractions** will be after this. We will explore what a fraction is, before adding, subtracting and converting them. We will then end the term looking at **Mass and Capacity** and solidifying our knowledge of what these two things are.

PHSE:

Strengths and Challenges – This unit will focus on celebrating our achievements and learning how to deal with and overcome setbacks. Saving, spending and budgeting – This will allow the pupils to explore money, how we store it, how people save it and what they save it for. We will look at the world of work and how we receive our money from a job. This will create great life skills for the children.
