English: In our writing this term, we will be using the book and film Kensuke's Kingdom! We will have a large focus on diary entries and informal language. We will also look in detail at relative clauses, active and passive voice, and using various punctuation marks accurately.

Maths: In maths, we will be finishing our final decimals block, before looking at how decimals, percentages and fractions link to one another. We will then focus on shape, statistics, ratio and proportion to round out the year. This is the part of the year where the maths we do becomes much more practical, and focuses on uses outside of the classroom.

Science: In science, we will be looking at human science, and how we change as we grow up. We will focus on the different life cycles of being a baby, child, teenager, adult, and finally what happens as you get older as an adult. We will look at the jobs, responsibilities and daily lives of people in each life cycle.

History and Geography: This term in history, we will be looking at crime as punishment, and how this has changed throughout history. We will then look at how this resulted in the police force developing into what we see today. In Geography, we will focus on sustainability.

DT/Art: In our DT sessions, we will be looking at the theme of gothic creations. We will focus on how we can use electrical circuits and components to enhance these.

PSHE: PSHE this term will focus on the topic 'being our best'. This will focus on how to aid and maintain our wellbeing, basic first aid, and how to identify and manage risks.

PE: We will have one P.E afternoon per week, on a Wednesday, and we will be focusing on athletics.

Home Learning: All pupils should read a minimum of three times a week, with an adult listening for at least one session. Pupils should also access TT Rockstars. There may also be some weekly homework based on the topics we have learned in class.

Computing: In computing, we will start to look at programming. We will look at how to create and programme multiple choice quizzes, and have a go at creating our own.

Music: Mrs. Devereaux will be teaching the children music, and will focus on the recorder.

Religious Education: This term we will be focussing on Christianity and Humanism, and what these groups consider as important.

French: This term, we will be focusing on locations in a city, and giving directions.
