English: In our writing this term, we will be using "The High Street" by Alice Melvin as our inspiration. The children will write their own stories about a trip to the High Street and the exciting things they find in each shop. We will focus on using adjectives to expand nouns and on using commas in our shopping lists.

Maths: We will kick off the summer term by looking at money and the children will learn all about the value of coins and notes. We will then be challenging ourselves by looking at fractions and time, before finally moving onto capacity and position/direction. At home, consider using timings as often as possible to help the children's understanding of time passing.

Science: This term we will be looking at Plants. We will be learning about the different parts of plants and what they need to help them grow. We will also learn about how we can group different plants together based on their characteristics.

History: This term, we will be learning about changes in technology. We will consider how technology has changed how we write, talk and access entertainment. It will be a great opportunity for children to think about how their lives would have been different in the past.

Geography: We will be focussing on our local area in geography and what we have available in our school grounds. We will also be thinking about the facilities we have nearby, such as Castle Hill. What are your favourite places to visit in Filleigh?

DT: In Design and technology, we will develop our understanding of healthy foods and design and create our own snacks. We will consider how hygiene plays an important role in maintaining our wellbeing.

PSHE:

Being My Best

Pupils learn:

- about eating well
- about the importance of sleep and physical exercise
- about people who help us to stay healthy
- Basic First Aid.

Religious Education: This term we will be learning **Why does Easter matter to Christians?** and **What makes some places sacred to believers?**

PE:

Pupils will have a double PE session on Wednesdays with Mrs Eggleton. We will be doing athletics and dance.

Home Learning: All pupils should read 3 times a week, using reading books (Year 2) or Big Cat Collins log ins (Year 1). Year 1 parents are welcome join us every Friday afternoon to read with children. We will also continue to send home our phonics sound of the week and spelling rules. Any additional home learning can be shared on Dojo.

Music: Mrs Devereaux will be teaching children about "Pop" and how to use their imagination in compositions. Pupils will use their voices creatively to sing and use a range of tuned and untuned instruments. They will experiment with creating sounds and use layers of music to blend their ideas together.

Computing:

E-Safety – Pupils will learn "When I doubt – discuss."
Teach computing – Pupils will be learning about how to design and create their own computer program and evaluating the output. How can we debug the program if it's not working how we want?
